17.00	<b>Ste.Clotilde</b>	Audition (organ concert)	<i>(only second Saturday of the month, Septembre-June)</i>
17.45	<b>Sainte-Madeleine (1846, III/58)</b>	Prelude of the 18.00-Mass	18.00 Take the Metro (ligne 12) to Assemblée Nationale and walk to SteClotilde (5 minutes)
18.25	<b>Sainte-Clotilde (1859, III/71):</b>	Evening Mass	Olivier Penin will be glad to welcome you on the organ tribune! 19.40 Very fast walk to Notre-Dame or RER C Musée d'Orsay – Notre Dame or bus 63 or walk to M St.Germain-desPrés and take the metro till St.Michel
20.00	<b>Notre-Dame-de-Paris</b>	Audition (organ concert)	
<b>SUNDAY</b>			
9.30	<b>Notre-Dame-de-Paris* (1867, V/113)*</b>	Laudes (choir organ), followed by the prelude (great organ) of the 10.00 Gregorian mass	End of mass: 11.20, you have all the time to walk to St. Sulpice (15 minutes) (or Metro line 4 (St.Michel to St.Sulpice))
10.45 OR 10.45	<b>St-Sulpice (1862, V/102)</b>  <b>Notre-Dame-de-la-Croix (1874, II(I)/26)</b>	Prelude of the 11.00 mass  Prelude of the 11.00 mass	5 minute walk to M Hotel de Ville, take line 11 to Belleville, change to line 2 to Ménilmontant, 5 minute walk to Notre-Dame-de-la-Croix
10.30	<b>Seven options</b>	See next page	if you want to be back for the audition of St. Sulpice, you have to leave after the prelude. Do mind these preludes are short. Of course you can also choose for a café crème with a croissant at the Cafè de la Mairie (at Place Saint Sulpice)
12.05	<b>St.Sulpice</b>	Audition (organ concert)	Visit to the organ loft cancelled due to 'security reasons'
13.30	<b>Lunch break</b>		Take a break now for a good lunch! Suggestion: Au Vieux Colombier, 65 rue Rennes (at the entrance of Metro St.Sulpice), a very nice and typical Parisian brasserie, which has conserved its art nouveau style
17.30	<b>St-Eustache</b>	Audition (organ concert)	18.00 Walk back to Notre-Dame-de-Paris
18.30 OR 18.45	<b>Notre-Dame-de-Paris*</b>  <b>St.Etienne-du-Mont</b>	Evening Mass  Evening Mass	At 17.45 there is an evening prayer, with interludes on the great organ  Prelude and sortie are short at St. Etienne-du-Mont...
* do mind the large queue for entering Notre Dame (5-10 minutes waiting time ☹)			
Two other organs you should visit (but they don't fit into any schedule): - Saint-Antoine-des-Quinze-Vingts (1894, III/46) (Sunday 10.45 AM) - Saint-Denis (1841, III/89) (Sunday 10.00 AM).			

**OTHER OPTIONS SUNDAY BETWEEN 10.00-11.30, attending the prelude of the 11.00 mass:**

- 10.30 5 minutes walk to Metro Mabillon and take ligne 10 to Cardinal Lemoine, 5-minute walk to **St. Etienne-du-Mont**
- 10.30 10-minutes walk to metro Sèvres-Babylone and take ligne 12, 2-minute walk to **Trinité**
- 10.30 10-minutes walk to metro Sèvres-Babylone and take ligne 12, 2-minute walk to **Madeleine**
- 10.30 10-minutes walk to metro Sèvres-Babylone and take ligne 10, 1-minute walk to **Église d'Auteuil** (not available till end 2017 due to maintenance works)
- 10.30 take ligne 4 to Réaumur-Sebastopol and take a 5-minute walk to **St-Nicolas-des-Champs**
- 10.30 take ligne 4 to Cité and take a 5-minute walk to **St-Gervais**
- 10.30 take ligne 4 to St-Michel and take a 10-minute walk to **St-Louis-en-l'île**
